MVCTC Students Recognized by the U.S. Department of Treasury

Clayton, Ohio –Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) students were recognized in December for their performance on the fall 2008 National Financial Literacy Challenge. The Office of Financial Education, U.S. Department of the Treasury describes the challenge as follows. "An initiative recommended by the President's Advisory Council on Financial Literacy, the 2008 National Financial Literacy Challenge is a voluntary recognition program for U.S. high school students. The Challenge's 35 questions correlate to the 2008 content standards published by the Jump\$tart Coalition for Personal Financial Literacy. The Challenge was developed by the U.S. Department of the Treasury in consultation with economists and the Jump\$tart coalition for Personal Financial Literacy, Junior Achievement USA, the National Council on Economic Education, and the National Endowment for Financial Education.
