Miami Valley Career Technology Center Announces New Superintendent

Clayton, Ohio – The Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Board of Education hired a new superintendent at the board meeting on June 12, 2012. Dr. Nick Weldy, current MVCTC Academic Supervisor, will officially take over the reins on August 1, 2012.

The board voted to appoint Dr. Weldy to succeed Dr. John Boggess who announced his retirement earlier this year. Dr. Boggess has been a key figure in Career Technical Education in the state of Ohio during his 36-year career. He has spent the past 15-years at MVCTC, where his work has been described as visionary in developing programs that help students be prepared for the 21st Century Workforce.

Dr. Weldy is only the fourth superintendent in MVCTC's 41-year history. In the course of his educational career, he has served as an administrator, teacher, and Board of Education member in both career-technical and traditional school districts in the Miami Valley. He is a graduate of Covington High School, located in Covington, Ohio, Sinclair Community College, with an Associate Degree with a Chemistry emphasis, Wright State University, with a B.S. in Biological Science Education and a Master's degree in Earth Science. Dr. Weldy earned his Ph.D. in Educational Leadership from the University of Dayton.

MVCTC serves more than 2,500 high school students in 27 school districts in Montgomery, Preble, Miami, Warren and Darke counties. In addition, 5,000 adults take courses and participate in skill training at the school each year.
